Vouchers must be redeemed by January 31, 2019 at Southwoods Health Covelli Centre box office only. They will not be valid day of show (February 1). Vouchers are awarded on first come, first serve basis. Limit of 200 total vouchers in price level 2 only. Additional tickets may be purchased in conjunction with the vouchers to accommodate families who wish to sit together.
- *Driver Meet-and-Greet:* A Monster Truck driver will be available for photos and autographs from 3p.m.-5 p.m. in addition to a Monster Truck
